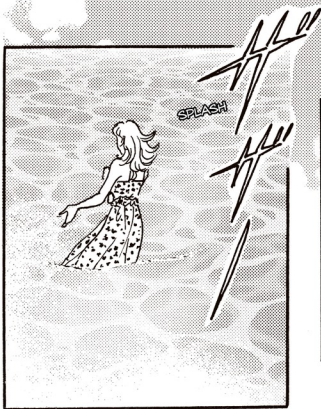




I lost my

three.

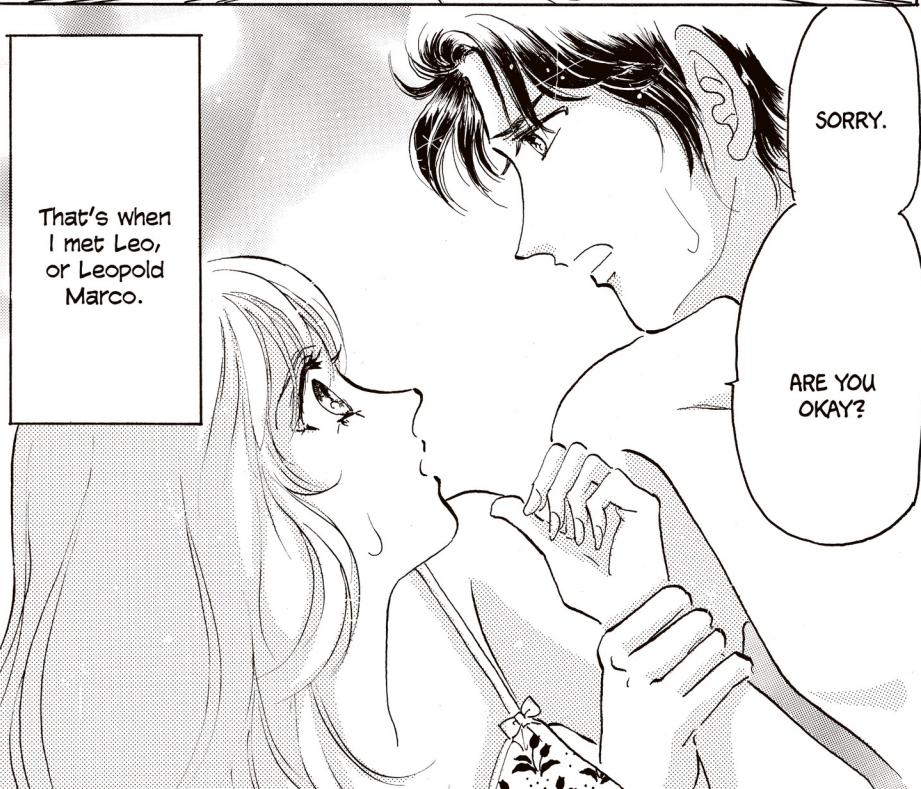

Hawaii

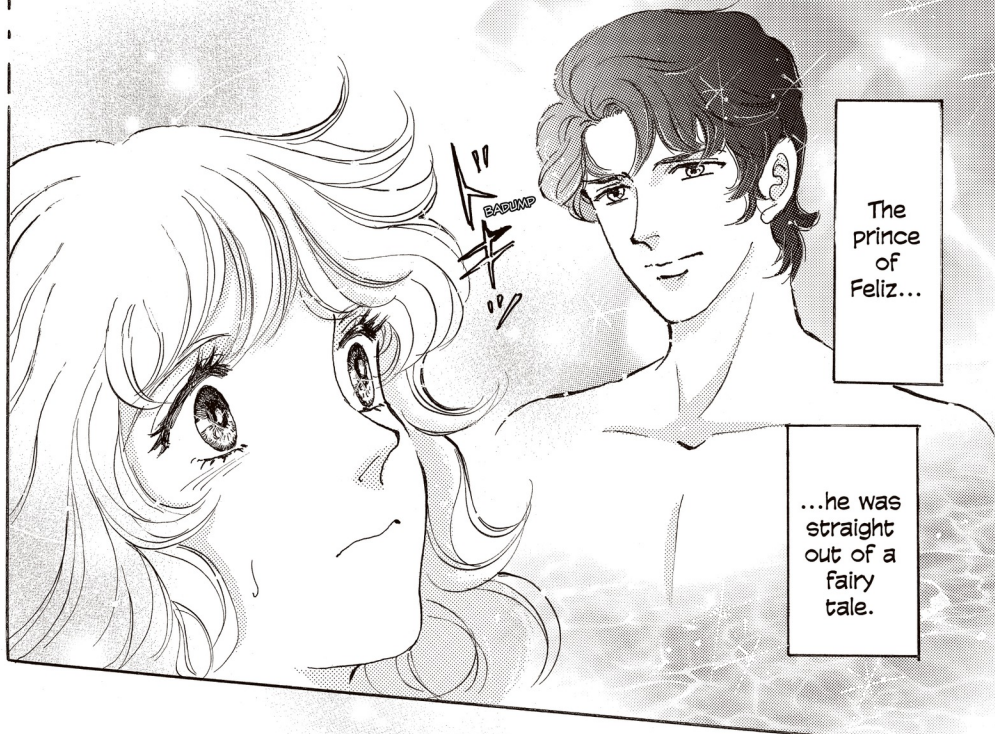
I'm spreading

to do.

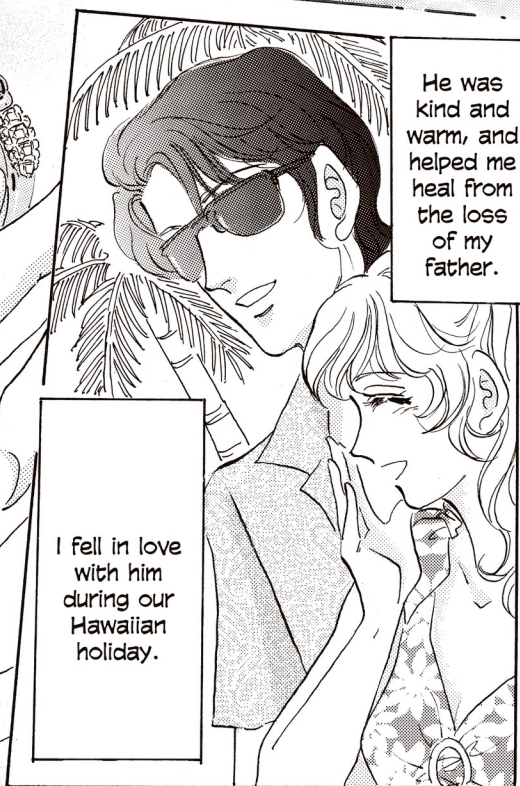




The prince

Feliz...

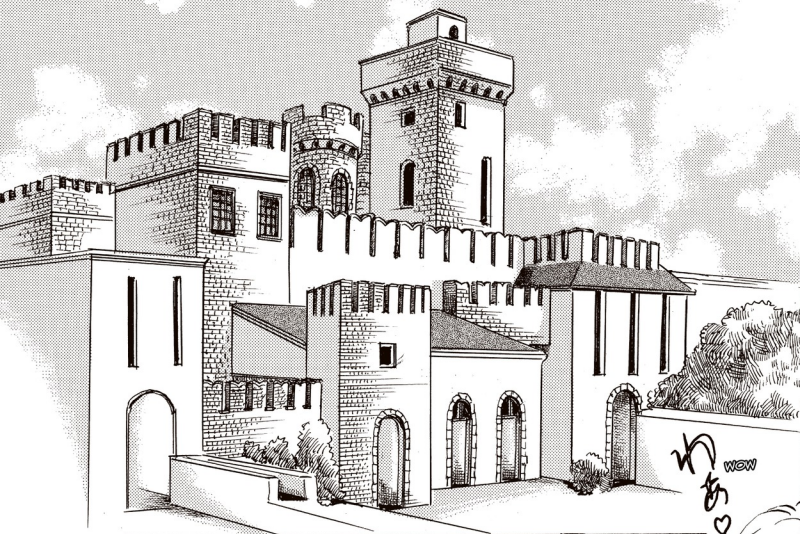
...he was

northern Italy.



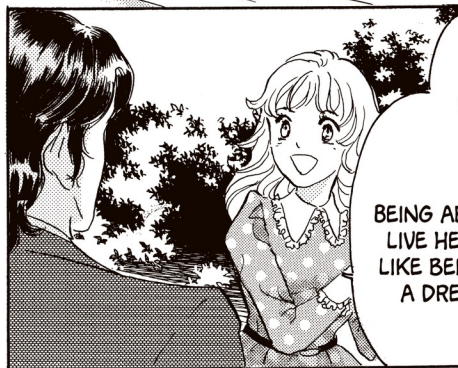
He was

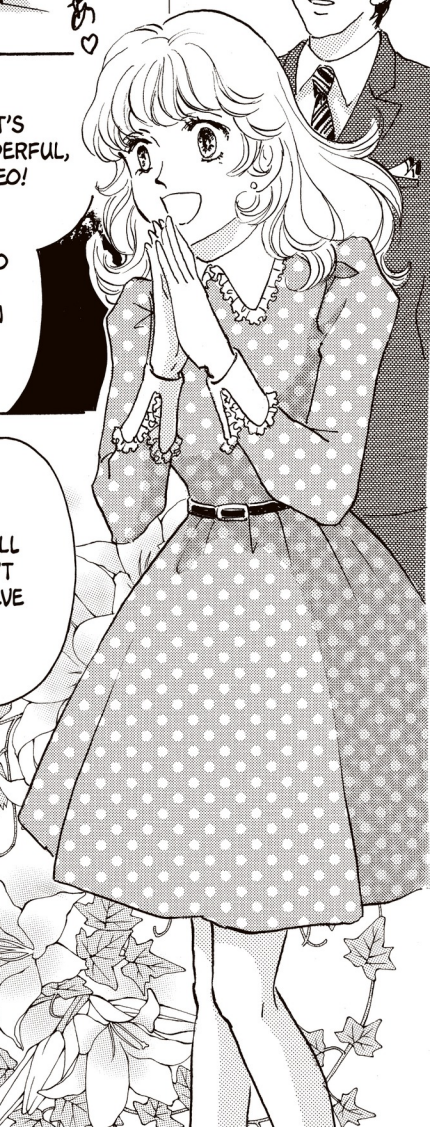

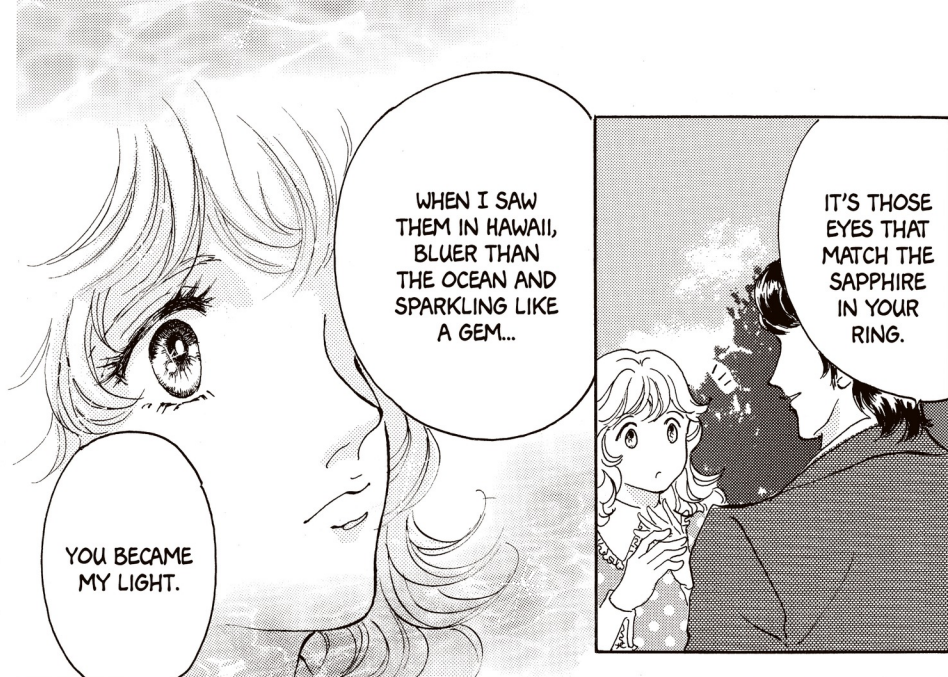

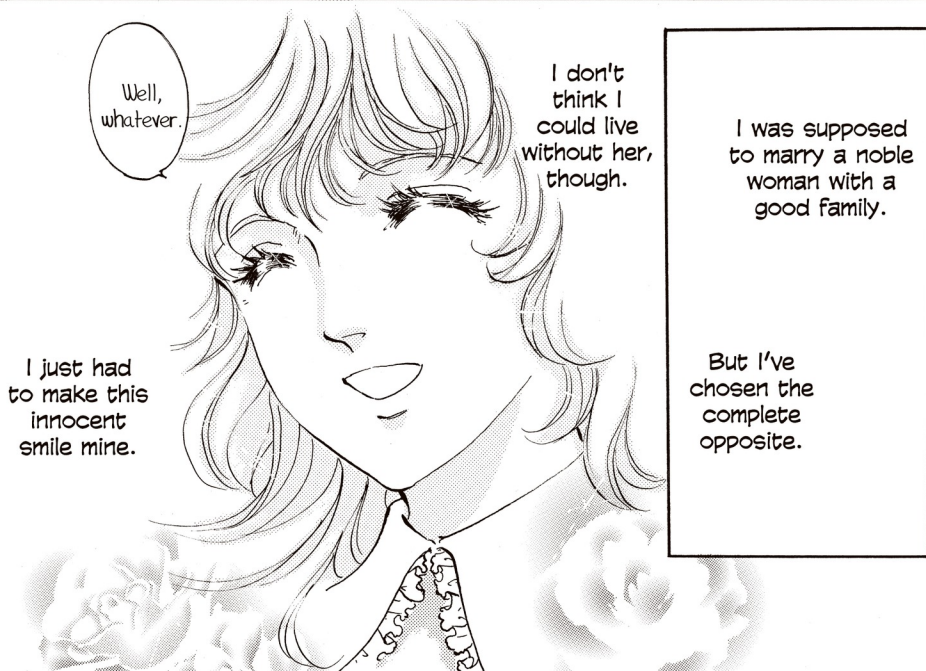


Why did I
