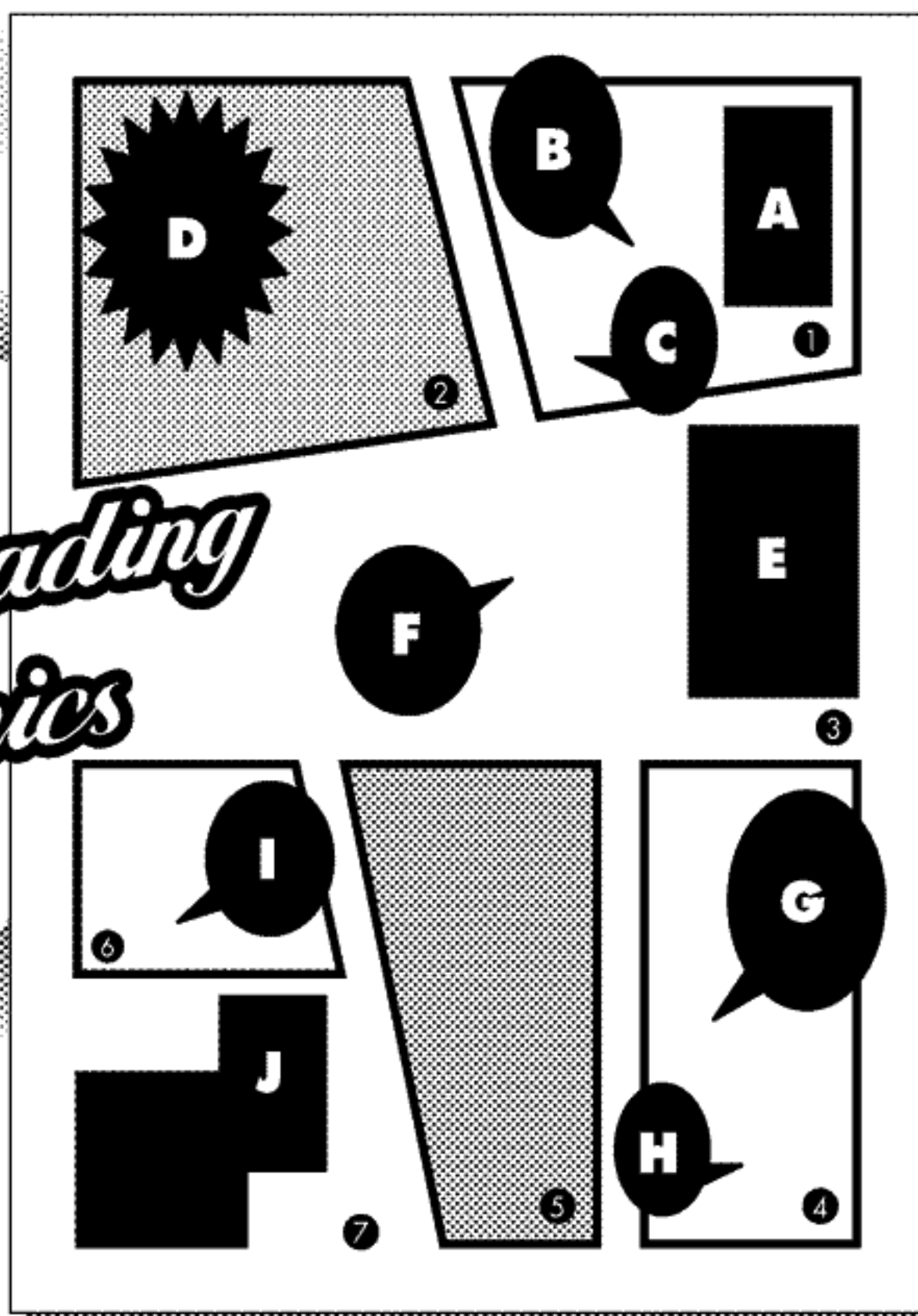


BEFORE YOU READ!

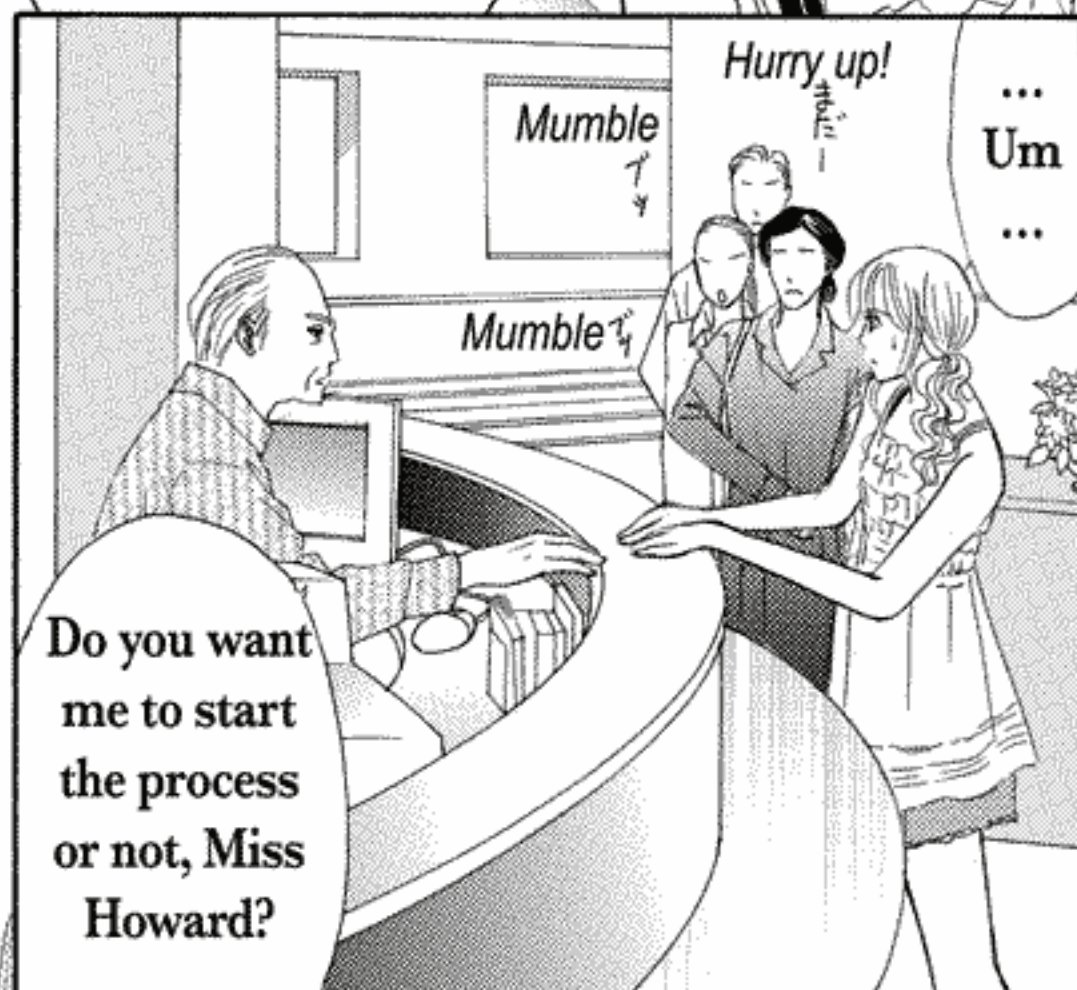

Bow



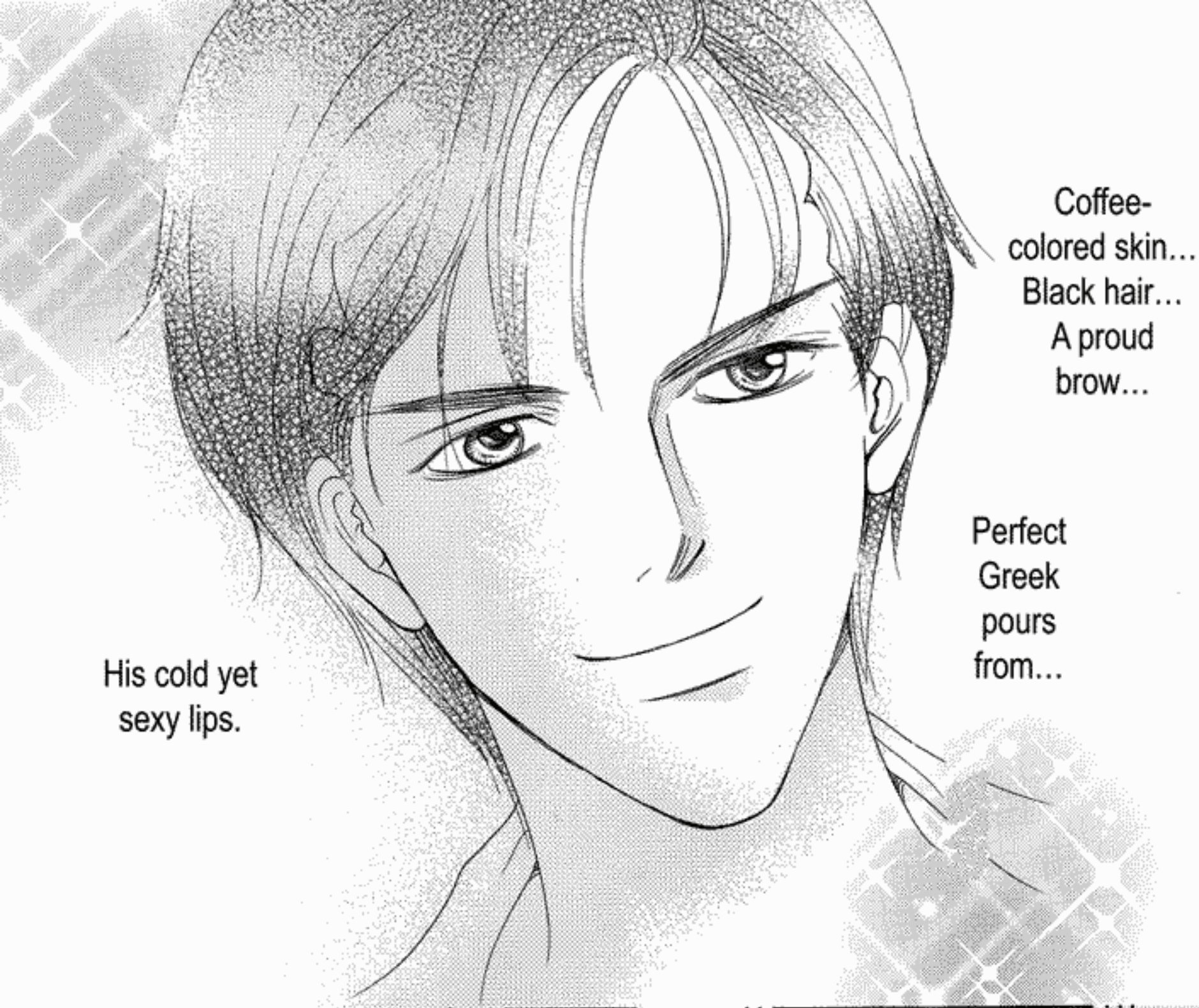

It'll be hard to live on only \$20 for the next 2 weeks, Christina.



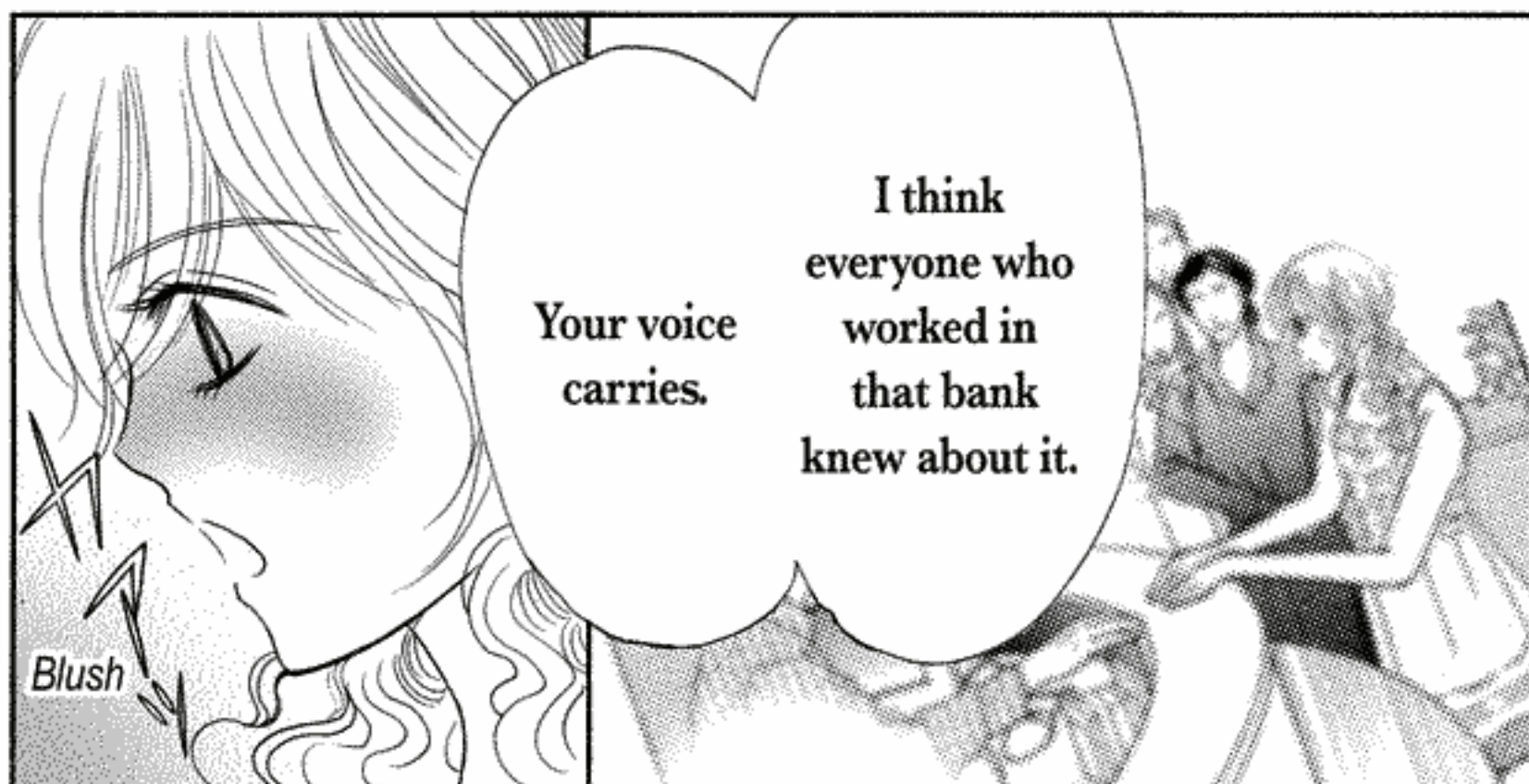
I think it would be wise to eat something that will make you feel full.

eat it.

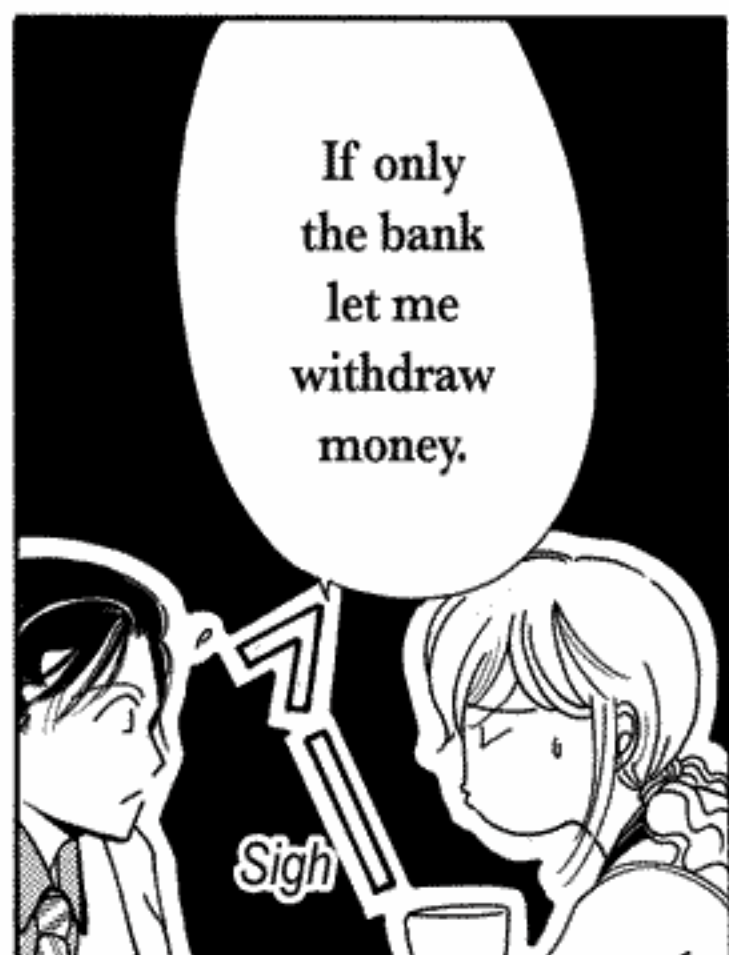

a ship.

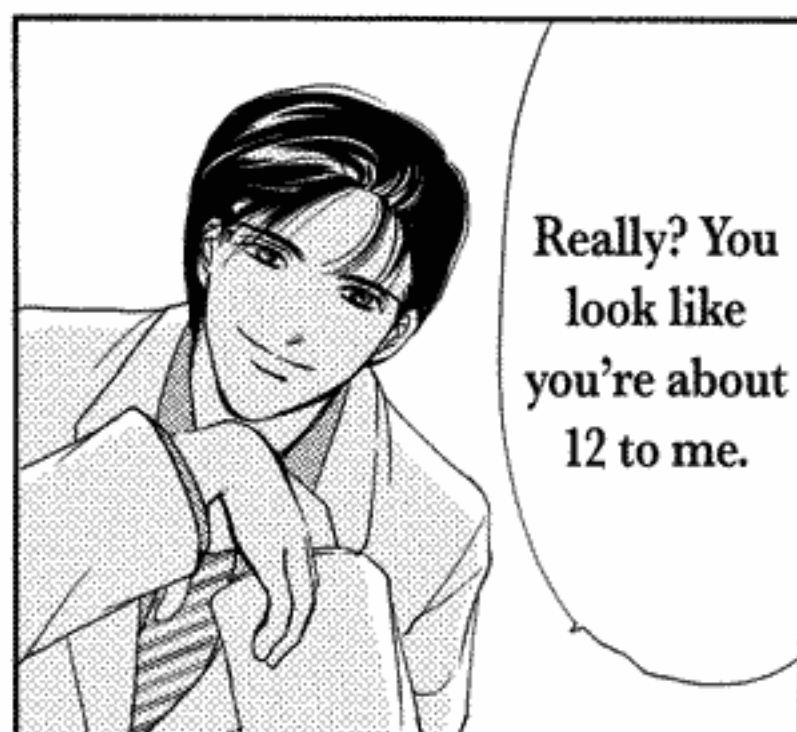




I thought
